East Cheshire NHS Trust is the main provider of acute health services for the people of eastern Cheshire, with a population of circa 200,000.

During 2007/08 82,315 patients attended the hospital, and the Trust delivered care to 48,000 people in A&E, 169,000 people as outpatients, 28,500 as inpatients and day cases. 2004 babies were born in hospital (plus 54 home births).

The Trust Objectives are:

- To continuously improve the experience for patients, in order to remain the hospital of choice
- To achieve the best possible standard of cleanliness in all the premises owned by the Trust.
- To continuously improve the development and support of staff.
- Develop the future of the Hospital with the public, commissioners and partners.

The Board intend to achieve Foundation Trust Status.

In order to achieve all these goals and continue to provide this level of care to the community we require the Blue Zone land and buildings, no longer fit for purpose and a drain on hospital resources, to be sold.

Following the previous proposals, recently rejected by the Council, the Trust and its development partners are looking to take on board the comments made by both the Council and local residents.

These revisions are now being considered and to ensure that the views of the public are reflected in the revised scheme a consultation event is again being held to give you the opportunity to comment
